## Are you ready?

Beginning May 7, 2025, residents of every U.S. state and territory will be required to present a REAL ID-compliant driver license or ID card, or another form of ID accepted by the Transportation Security Administration, to board federally regulated domestic flights.

Individuals must also present a REAL ID-compliant driver license or ID card to access federal facilities, including military bases and federal courthouses, and to enter nuclear power plants.





Missouri's REAL ID-compliant driver licenses and nondriver ID cards will have a star in the upper right-hand corner. A license or ID card that is not compliant with REAL ID will have "Not for REAL ID Purposes" in the upper right-hand corner.














## WHAT IS REAL ID?

"REAL ID" comes from the REAL ID Act of 2005, a federal law that focused on fraud protection, anti-terrorism, and driver license and nondriver license identification card (ID card) security. The REAL ID Act prohibits federal agencies from accepting driver licenses and ID cards from states that do not meet these standards. Access to federal facilities open to the general public for purposes of applying for or receiving federal benefits will continue to be allowed.

Beginning May 7, 2025, every air traveler 18 years of age and older will be required to present a REAL ID-compliant driver license or ID card, or another form of ID accepted by the Transportation Security Administration, to board federally regulated domestic flights.

## **DOES MISSOURI LAW** REQUIRE ME TO HOLD A REAL ID-COMPLIANT DRIVER LICENSE OR NONDRIVER ID CARD?

No. Under Missouri law, applying for a REAL ID-compliant driver license or nondriver ID card is optional. However, individuals who choose not to get one will still be required to present another form of acceptable identification to fly domestically, access federal facilities and enter nuclear power plants beginning May 3, 2023.













## HOW DO I APPLY FOR A REAL ID?

You can apply for a REAL ID-compliant driver license or nondriver ID card at one of Missouri's more than 170 license office locations. You will be required to submit valid, original documents from each of the categories below at the time you apply:

- Identity (i.e. Birth Certificate, Passport)
- Lawful Status
- Social Security Number
- Proof of Missouri Residency (2 documents from different sources required i.e. Utility Bill, Voter Registration)
- Name Change Document

### WHAT IS THE COST OF OBTAINING A REAL ID-COMPLIANT DRIVER LICENSE OR NONDRIVER ID CARD?

The transaction and processing fees for a REAL ID-compliant driver license or nondriver ID card, new or renewal, are the same as for a license or ID card that is noncompliant with REAL ID. Detailed fee information can be found at dor.mo.gov/ driver-license/resources/license.html#fees.

### \* MILITARY POLICY CHANGE

The U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) recently finalized an update to its DoD-wide installation security policy and is in the process of no longer accepting noncompliant marked cards across all of its facilities and installations. This means the military is in the process of no longer accepting driver licenses or nondriver identification cards marked as being noncompliant with REAL ID for the purposes of accessing a military base. This policy change impacts DoD installations in all states, not just Missouri.

Prior to May 7, 2025, military bases will accept licenses and ID cards marked as being REAL ID-compliant or Missouri licenses and ID cards issued prior to March 25, 2019, which have no REAL ID marking, compliant or noncompliant. In Missouri, a license or ID card that is noncompliant with REAL ID will have "Not for REAL ID Purposes" in the upper right-hand corner. Anyone attempting to access a military base with a Missouri-issued license or ID card marked as "Not for REAL ID Purposes" may be denied entry.

To ensure you have the proper identification, you should contact the military base you plan to visit in advance to obtain information regarding identification requirements.
