

# It's Time to Renew Your Driver License, Nondriver License, or Instruction Permit

Be prepared for a successful renewal. Bring your current driver license or nondriver license and follow these three steps. We've provided "**Commonly Used**" items to expedite the processing of your renewal. Visit [www.dor.mo.gov](http://www.dor.mo.gov) for more detailed information.

## Step 1 - Verify Your Social Security Number

- Social security card - Show the license office clerk your social security card or just tell the clerk your social security number.
- No social security card - Provide the license office clerk a letter from the Social Security Administration regarding your status.

**Commonly Used:** Verbally provide number

## Step 2 - Name, Date of Birth, Place of Birth

**U.S. Citizens** must present one of the following: U.S. Birth Certificate (certified with an embossed, stamped, or raised seal and issued by a vital records agency; Hospital birth certificates and birth registration cards are not accepted.); U.S. Passport (valid or expired); A "copy" of a U.S. Birth Certificate (issued by a vital records agency) accompanied by a U.S. Military I.D. Card or Military Discharge Papers; U.S. Certificate of Citizenship, Naturalization, or Birth Abroad.

**Non-U.S. Citizens** must present appropriate immigration documents indicating current status.

**Age 65 and Older Exemption** - If you are renewing a non-commercial permit, driver license, or nondriver license, you are exempt from presenting documentation for place of birth.

**Has your name changed since your last license?** If your name doesn't match the name on this postcard or on your license, bring one of the following documents: Certified Marriage Certificate; Certified Divorce Decree; Certified Court Order; Certified Adoption Papers Amended Birth Certificate; U.S. Passport (valid or expired); Social Security; or Medicare Card.

**Commonly Used:** Certified U.S. Birth Certificate, Immigration Documents, or Certified Court Order

## Step 3 - Verify Your Residential Address

All applicants should show residence with any recent document from this list: Pay Check; Mortgage Document; Housing Rental Contract; Property Tax Receipt; Utility Bill; Voter Registration Card; Driver License Renewal Postcard; Motor Vehicle Renewal Postcard

**Note:** A Post Office Box is not acceptable as a residential address. You need to show proof of residential address and alternate mailing address (if applicable). Current addresses are important! **Your license will be mailed to the address provided.**
