Complete the information above and mail this notification to the owner and lienholder of record by certified mail. If the owner does not present the Certificate of Title within 30 days, you may apply for a Certificate of Title or Junking Certificate by submitting the following items to the Department of Revenue:

1. Application for Title by an Insurance Company, ([Form 5042](#));
2. Vehicle Examination Certificate ([Form 551](#)) completed by authorized personnel of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, or St. Louis City or County Auto Theft;
  - Application For Vehicle/Trailer Identification Number Plate or Verification, ([Form 5062](#)) for trailers; or
  - Boat or Outboard Motor Affidavit of Ownership and Inspection, ([Form 798](#)) for Vessel or Watercraft.
3. \$8.50 title fee for vehicle or \$7.50 title fee for vessel or watercraft (No title fee is required for a Junking Certificate.);
4. Certified mail receipt(s) verifying proof of notification; and
5. \$9.00 processing fee.
