Mechanic Lien Title

Complete the information above and mail this notification to the vehicle owner(s) and lienholder(s) of record by certified mail. If the owner does not redeem or a satisfactory agreement has not been made within 30 days, the mechanic or garage indicated on this form may apply for a mechanic lien title by submitting the following documents to the Department of Revenue:

1. *Application for Missouri Title and License* ([Form 108](#)) (for motor vehicles, trailers, all-terrain vehicles, and manufactured homes) or *Application for Missouri Boat/Vessel or Outboard Motor Title and Registration* ([Form 93](#)) (for vessels or outboard motors). For type of title, record "mechanic lien";
 - For a motor vehicle in which the model year is 2011 or newer and the motor vehicle is less than 20 years old, the odometer reading must be reported on the title application. If the true mileage is unknown, a statement containing all known facts regarding the true mileage is required.
2. *Notarized Mechanic Lien Affidavit* ([Form 1062](#));
3. Signed work order, storage agreement, or tow agreement;
4. A statement showing the outstanding balance for all labor, services, skills, materials, or storage costs accumulated up to the date of application for title;
5. A copy of the 30-day *Notice of Owner(s) and Lienholder(s) Regarding Intent to File for Mechanic Lien Title* ([Form 5835](#)) or similar notice sent by certified mail and evidence the notices were sent;
6. Evidence the notices were sent include the tracking documentation from an established national postal or parcel delivery service (including, but not limited to, the US Post Office, Federal Express, or United Parcel Service etc.) If the certified notice is returned to sender, submit a copy of the envelope stamped "return to sender";
7. If the vehicle is not currently titled in Missouri; and
 - Copy of the out-of-state title search indicating the owner(s) and lienholder(s) of record; and
 - A vehicle identification number and odometer reading inspection completed by an authorized *Missouri inspection station or an Application for Vehicle/Trailer Identification Number Plate or Verification* ([Form 5062](#)).
8. \$10.00 title fee and \$9.00 processing fee.
