



Sales Tax Exemption Statement For Public Utility Company

Effective August 28, 2024, pursuant to 144.058, RSMo., Missouri Sales Tax will not be assessed on motor vehicles, trailers, boats, or motors owned by public utility companies, and used to facilitate the generation, transmission, distribution, sale, or furnishing of electricity. This form must be completed prior to application for title if it's not listed on the Public Service Commission website at psc.mo.gov/UtilityLocator.aspx. All applications must be in the public utility company's business name to qualify for exemption.

Public Utility Company Information section containing fields for Public Utility Company Name, Purchase Date, Telephone Number, Doing Business As, Address, City, State, ZIP Code, and FEIN.

Vehicle Information section containing three rows of fields for Vehicle Identification Number (VIN), Year, Make, Model, Purchase Date, and KOV.

Signature section containing a declaration statement and fields for Public Utility Company Authorized Agent Signature, Printed Name, and Date.

Instructions section listing six steps for public utility companies to qualify for exemption from sales tax.
