FIGURING TAX ON \$9,000 OR LESS

Example: If Line 10 is \$3,090, the tax would be computed as follows: \$60 + \$2.70 (3% of \$90) = \$62.70. The whole dollar amount to enter on Line 11 would be \$63.

IGURING TAX OVER \$9,000

Example If more than \$9,000, tax is \$315 PLUS 6% of Missouri taxable income (Line 10) \$ 12,000 excess over \$9,000.
