

Notice of Cycle Registration

Effective August 28, 2018, Senate Bill 881 changed the expiration month of all cycle registrations from April to June.

At the time of registration renewal, applicants with a standard cycle license plate will receive a new bicentennial design license plate displaying the expiration month of June. Registration fees on all renewal notices and on the Department's Renewal Requirements Inquiry website include an additional two-month registration fee to extend the registration expiration month from April to June.



Current specialty plate holders will not receive a bicentennial design license plate, but will continue to hold and display their specialty plate.

In addition to registration expiration year stickers, a June month sticker will be issued at the time of registration renewal to be placed over the 'APR' (April) designation currently displayed on the plate.
