

Registration holders with personalized license plates that have the bluebird design will receive a letter notifying them that their plates will need to be remade and shipped to the license office of their choice prior to the plate expiration date. These notifications are being mailed in advance to provide sufficient time for response. No action is necessary before receiving the notification.
