SECTION II

PURPOSES OF CID AND SERVICES PERFORMED:

The purpose of the CID is to provide assistance to construct, reconstruct, install, repair, maintain, and equip certain public improvements within its boundaries and to support business activity and economic development throughout the district. The CID imposes a district sales tax at a rate of one percent (1%) to finance and administer these improvements and services.

The services provided by the CID include district restoration and beautification, infrastructure repair and improvement, and administration. More specifically, the CID provided funding for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a community center within Jefferson Barracks Park. Additionally, the CID provided funding for landscaping, beautification, repair, and maintenance of a portion of River City Casino Boulevard located within the district.

Resolution No. 21-CID-01 Presented to the Board November 18, 2021

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PROPOSED BUDGET OF THE DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Lemay Community Improvement District (the "<u>District</u>") is a community improvement district and a political subdivision of the State of Missouri organized under the Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67.1401 to 67.1571 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended (the "<u>CID Act</u>"); and

WHEREAS, Section 67.010 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, requires each political subdivision of the State of Missouri to prepare an annual budget prior to the beginning of the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.1471 of the CID Act requires that the District shall submit the proposed annual budget to the County Council of St. Louis County, Missouri (the "County Council") for written comment, which shall be provided to the District no later than sixty days prior to the first day of the relevant fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, staff serving the District submitted the proposed budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, in substantially the form set forth on **Exhibit A**, to staff for the County Council on September 29, 2021, which was included in the County Council's meeting materials on October 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS, to date, staff serving the District has not received written comments from the County Council related to the proposed budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, in substantially the form set forth on **Exhibit A**.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Lemay Community Improvement District as follows:

- **Section 1.** Approval and Adoption of Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2022. The proposed budget of the District for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, is hereby approved and adopted as set forth on **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- **Section 2. Further Authority**. All actions heretofore taken by the authorized representatives, agents, and employees of the District in connection with the transaction contemplated by this Resolution are hereby ratified and confirmed, and the District shall, and the representatives, agents, and employees of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action and execute and deliver such other documents and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.
- **Section 3. Severability**. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution shall be severable. In the event that any such section, paragraph, sentence, clause,

or phrase of this Resolution is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Resolution are valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Resolution are so essential to and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portion that it cannot be presumed that the District has enacted the valid portions without the void ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions, standing alone, are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

- **Section 4. Governing Law**. This Resolution shall be governed exclusively by and construed in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Missouri.
- **Section 5. Effective Date**. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage by the District.

Lemay Community Improvement District Budget for Year Ending December 31, 2022

The Lemay Community Improvement District ("<u>CID</u>") was created, along with the St. Louis County Port Improvement District No. 1 ("<u>PID</u>"), to provide funding for the development, operation, and maintenance of The Pavilion at Lemay (the "<u>Community Center Project</u>"), along with any related public improvement, activities, or services and projects for the landscaping, beautification, repair, and maintenance of the River City Casino Boulevard (the "<u>Pinnacle</u> Project").

Receipts:

Sales tax revenues for the CID and the PID are conservative estimates based on the prior budget year.

Given the purpose of the CID and the PID is to support specific projects with regular distribution of funds and expected low interest rates, staff anticipates minimal earnings from cash flow.

Disbursements:

Staff for the St. Louis County Port Authority (the "<u>Port</u>") will be responsible for day-to-day administrative operations of the CID and PID. Staff track time devoted to these tasks, and the Port is reimbursed for the actual cost of its staff's time devoted to the CID. Costs related to administrative operations are estimated based on the prior budget year.

The budget provides for disbursement of all remaining revenue to support the projects identified above. However, it is anticipated that all disbursements will be allocated to the Community Center Project, consistent with the requirements of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement among St. Louis County, the Port, and the CID, dated January 16, 2016.
