BUDGET MESSAGE:

The Parkville Market Place #2 Community Improvement District was established by the City Council of Parkville, Missouri on June 5, 2018.

It is anticipated that the District's Board of Directors and the owners of the real property within the District will approve a 1% CID sales and use tax in June 2018, with the tax becoming effective on October 1, 2018.

It is anticipated that a Cooperative Agreement will be entered into by the District, the Developer, and the City, whereby the Developer will advance funds needed to pay for the District's operating costs (including, without limitation, formation costs) and to construct certain public improvements, and the CID will reimburse the Developer (with interest) with CID revenues as such revenues are collected over time.
