The Peculiar Main Street Community Improvement District was established by the Board of Aldermen of Peculiar, Missouri on May 18, 2020. The District was formed for the purposes of providing revenue sources to assist with and support the financing of the costs of certain improvements that serve the area encompassing the District. The District's sole source of revenue is a 0.50% sales tax, the collection of which commences on January 1, 2021 and terminate after 22 years.
