<u>Date of and Ordinance No</u>: Petition to Establish the District filed with City of Ellisville, Missouri on June 29, 2018, and approved via Ordinance 3386, passed by the City of Ellisville, Missouri City Council on August 1, 2018. The District was formed for the purpose of providing revenue sources to fund the costs of certain improvements that serve the area encompassing the District.

The District's primary source of revenue is a sales and use tax, the collection of which commenced in 2020 and will terminate in 2039. The entirety of the District's sales and use tax revenues may be used for any purposes specified in the Petition.

The District has issued a note to the Developer for costs incurred in completing the Projects described in the Petition. The District began making payments on the Note in January 2022.

No major changes are expected for the District during fiscal year 2023.

The District has adopted a fiscal year beginning January 1 and ending December 31 of each year.
