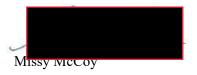

### VILLAGE SQUARE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 BUDGET

**BUDGET MESSAGE** 

The Village Square Community Improvement District (the "District") was formed as a political subdivision of the State of Missouri on August 21, 2019, by the City of Hazelwood, Missouri by the approval of a petition for formation (the "Petition") by Ordinance No. 4709-19. The District was formed for the purpose of providing sales tax and special assessment revenue sources to fund the costs of certain improvements that serve the area encompassing the District.

The District's primary source of revenue is a special assessment and sales and use tax. The District imposes a 1% sales and use tax on all sales at retail made within the District. The District has the authority to impose a special assessment in the amount of \$1.00 per square foot of building located within the District. The collection of the special assessment commenced in the fall of 2020 and will terminate in 2045. The collection of the sales and use tax commenced January 1, 2020 and will terminate December 31, 2044. The proceeds of the District's special assessment and sales tax revenues may be used for any purposes specified in the Petition.

Major changes: The District has completed the District project and intends to issue a note to Hazelwood - 7107 North Lindbergh Blvd, LLC, the Developer, during fiscal year 2023-2024.

The District has adopted a fiscal year beginning July 1 and ending June 30 of each year.
